► DOCUMENT PRODUCTION

► Document production, a rather simple name for a sophisticated, efficient and reliable production process. The process runs under the limits of strict deadlines: every Thursday is publication day for patent applications, patents and utility models in Germany. Week for week up to 2,000 documents are digitized, OCR-scanned and structured according to the meta language XML. At the same time the documents are edited in a searchable way for internet-publication and for offline-publication on CD-ROM. Also PDF-documents are created, allowing for a simple paper print.

Based on international standards of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) the XML-structuring of the pretentious content, mostly including formulas or tables, allows for the largely automatized capture, mapping and forwarding of documents and data fields. The XML-structuring is also an indispensable precondition for the future retrieval capacity on the internet/intranet or on DVD/CD-ROM. Only such a retrievable database publication makes sense in view of the large number and the complex content of the documents.

Production und Publication as Integrated System

The thorough integration of production und online-publication of documents is a speciality of Bundesdruckerei.

The long standing experience and the know-how of Bundesdruckerei are reflected in the production process itself. Worldwide standards give security and transparency, individually developed automatization tools warrant efficiency and allow to meet the strict deadlines. The specific assignment of experienced personnel guaranties the required high quality and accuracy.
